During the hand exercise he was more interested in playing than anything else, and did not react to the tester (even when he does not know) to touch his toes. Overall he has been seen to score well and this seems to have skewed him a bit. He was a bit *concerned when the tester pretended to injure a sore paw, see he did not be the best pick for an emotional support animal. While his concern was sweet, he became very worried and would probably be too sensitive to be exposed to those situations regularly. We consider him to be a 'middle of the pack' boy that will do well in almost any situation.

Yukon was great with most touch but his 'scratches' on his tummy resulted in him getting 'power' or 'ouch' to 'ouch' and thus reduced his suitability for a home with young children. Touch tolerance can be modified with training and should be enjoyable for most. He could still do well with a young family who was willing to train him. His test demonstrated high prey drive and high motivation to please, but needed to build a rapport first. High prey drive is a desirable trait for those who want a dog to fetch, play frisbee, or similar games.
